

Little Moth!

Objective:

You are a refined and worldly moth, a connoisseur of cloth and texture. As you fold your laundry, you indulge in the art of textile tasting, savoring the fabrics as though they were exquisite dishes from a grand banquet.

How to Play:

Pick up a piece of clothing. Run your fingers over the fabric. Observe its color, texture, weight. What does it taste like? Not to *you*, of course, but to a moth with a refined palate. Describe it as if you were a food critic, indulging in a world of culinary delights woven from cotton, wool, and silk.

Suggestions for Flavor Profiles:

Some fabrics are naturally *sweet*, soft as spun sugar, light as a delicate pastry. Others are *salty*, crisp and briny, like something left to dry in the sea air. Dark, heavy garments might carry the depth of *bitterness*, rich and lingering, while bright, zippy fabrics have the sharp tang of *sour*. And then there's *umami*—deep, complex, a warmth that settles into the bones.

You might decide that all socks are salty today. Or that jeans, no matter their wash, always have the umami of a well-aged cheese. Perhaps today's laundry is a five-course meal, each item adding a new note to the feast.

Some Inspirations:

- A **fluffy white towel** could be a *pillowy soufflé, dusted with vanilla sugar, collapsing into airy sweetness at the first bite*.
- A **well-worn flannel** might be a *slow-smoked brisket, caramelized at the edges, steeped in memory*.
- A **bright yellow raincoat** could taste *like preserved lemons and sea spray, tart and bracing with the promise of a storm*.
- A **stiff black blazer** might hold *the deep bitterness of espresso, aged leather, and the faintest whisper of regret*.
- A **pair of sweatpants** could be a *rich bowl of ramen, thick with broth, something you settle into and never want to leave*.

Optional Ways to Play:

- **Speed Round:** Don't think—just taste.
- **Theme Tasting:** Everything today is umami. Or maybe all dark colors are bitter.
- **Pairings:** What does this sweater go with? A scarf? A pair of gloves? Is it a full course meal or a single bite?
- **Judge's Panel:** If playing with others, take turns describing an item and voting on the most delicious description.

There are no wrong answers—only an endless buffet of flavor waiting to be discovered in the folds of your laundry.
